

ECFG10 Neurospora Satellite Meeting
When: 29 March 2010 9AM until 3PM
Where: Leiden University Medical Center (LUMC)
Albinusdreef 2, 2333 ZA Leiden

The LUMC is immediately behind the train station in Leiden, which is only a few minutes from Schiphol airport by train. Leave the train station, head towards LUMC (the opposite direction from the city center) and look for this building:



Go into the building and follow the signs to Col. Zaal 4 (lecture room 4). This is located between the J and K sections of the building. There is an information stand just inside the main entrance. They are very helpful there, don't hesitate to ask before going into this huge complex!

Fees: We will collect 50 euros from PI's and 30 euros from students and post-docs to cover the cost of administration, coffee/tea, lunch and transportation from Leiden to the meeting site. You will pay this via the ECFG10 registration website.

Program: to be announced. In general, we will have short talks from junior investigators and a plenary lecture. Please indicate if you would like to give a short presentation when you register. We would like to hear what is going on with Neurospora around Europe. New methods, new ideas?

We have a special price at Hotel Rembrandt. You can get 10% off the normal room rate if you tell them that you are with the Neurospora satellite meeting. If they are full (they are not a huge hotel), there are many other hotels in Leiden and it is a small city so it will be easy to find each other, regardless!
