

**Poster Instructions and late abstracts**

Abstracts can be submitted for presentation and included in the abstract book up until the print deadline of **22 February 2010**. However, for your abstract to be included in the abstract book you must also register and pay on or before 22 February 2010. Authors not registered by this date will have their abstract removed.

After 22 February late abstracts for poster presentation will still be accepted but won't be included in the abstract book.

And include the following information:

1. Title
2. Authors and affiliations
3. Abstract – no more than 250 words and in English
4. Category
  - 1) Phylogeny and Fungal Tree of Life
  - 2) Fungal-Host Biology
  - 3) Regulation of Gene Expression at the Genome Level
  - 4) Fungal Physiology & Biochemistry
  - 5) Fungal Way of Living; Sex and Other Encounters
  - 6) Fungal Way of Living; Cell Biology
  - 7) Fungal and Oomycete Effectors
  - 8) Fungal Biotechnology

As the presenting author you must include a photograph of yourself in the poster. Posters must be no more than A0 in size (841mm x 1189mm), and Portrait in format.

There will be a prize awarded to the 5 best posters presented by PhD students of €200. If you qualify and would like to be considered for a prize please clearly mark your poster in the top right hand corner with an orange dot. This prize is sponsored by DSM.

Posters are to be displayed from 4pm on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> March until after the last poster session on Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> April .
